SAFETY WHEEL CHOCKS

MODEL NO. TD3553

YOUR FOLDABLE WHEEL CHOCKS HAVE BEEN DESIGNED TO BE USED IN CONJUNCTION WITH ALL LIFTING EQUIPMENT TO HELP PROVIDE A SAFE, STABLE LIFTING CONDITION. FOLDABLE WHEEL CHOCKS ARE NOT SUPPORT DEVICES AND SHOULD NOT BE USED TO RAISE OR TO PERMANENTLY SUPPORT/SECURE A VEHICLE TO PREVENT MOVEMENT. PLEASE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS AND WARNINGS. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN PERSONAL INJURY AND/OR PROPERTY DAMAGE.

HOW TO USE:

1. Place automatic transmission selector in park, place manual shift selector in gear with the emergency brake engaged.
2. To prevent further vehicle movement, wheels should be securely blocked with foldable wheel chocks.

To Use Chocks:



Unfold and pull out support bar to stop



Lock support and bar in groove

3. Always use foldable wheel chocks in pairs, one pair per tire. If more than one tire is to be blocked, use additional pairs of foldable wheel chocks. Refer to the picture below.

4. Always position foldable wheel chocks so each is centered on the tread of the tire. off center positioning could cause sudden instability, resulting in personal injury and/or property damage.
